RETINAL PHOTOGRAPHY

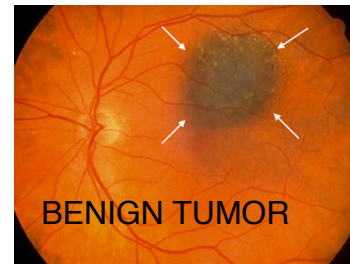
Digital Retinal Photography is a highly sensitive camera that can better help us **detect** disease such as Glaucoma, Diabetic Retinopathy, Hypertension, Macular Degeneration, Tumors, and other retinal abnormalities. For **healthy eyes** it provides a baseline for future reference. This is especially important for patients with a history of systemic illness, such as high blood pressure, floaters and/or flashes of light, or a strong eyeglass prescription.

OPTICAL COHERENCE TOMOGRAPHY (OCT)

OCT compares to an MRI and is a non-invasive imaging test that uses light waves to take cross-section pictures of your retina, the light-sensitive tissue lining the back of the eye. OCT measurements may help with early detection of retinal diseases such as age-related macular degeneration and diabetes, among others.

VISUAL FIELD TESTING

A visual field test measures an individual's central and peripheral (side) vision. Visual field testing is most frequently used to detect signs of glaucoma, but is also important for screening macular degeneration, retinal detachments, plaquenil management, migraine headaches or other brain abnormalities.
